



Ontario Hockey Federation Scholarship Program

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) Scholarship Program has been operating as the Bursary Program since 1997. Although the name has changed the intent to recognize and reward dedication in education and hockey has stayed the same. The program provides financial assistance to registered OHF participants to offset the cost of post-secondary education. In the past 22 years, the OHF has distributed more than \$400,000 to over 360 post-secondary students.

Each year, the OHF awards scholarships to outstanding young people who display an incredible amount of commitment both at the arena and in the classroom. The scholarship recipients are determined on the basis of academic achievements, hockey involvement and community involvement.

To be eligible to receive a scholarship, a candidate must meet the following criteria:

- 1** Be registered for three (3) years within the OHF in any capacity (player, trainer, coach, official)
- 2** Be registered with the OHF during their application season
- 3** Be a registrant in good standing with the OHF
- 4** Enrolling in post-secondary full-time studies in Canada for the first time
