The tournaments continue to get bigger (which is a good thing) and are involving both rinks, more officials, timekeepers and games than ever before. This past weekend we also had to bring in officials from Bracebridge for morning games at the BOCC and afternoon games in Humphrey as we do not have enough locally. I also feel a bit of conflict of interest as I am

also an official myself and am there reffing most of the weekend in addition to my tournament role and don't want to get into trouble for spending club funds. I have receipts to submit to Jess for this past weekend. Lastly, moving forward, I am wondering if we could get someone from the club to come and help hand out medals and banners at the end of the tournament finals? I did it this past weekend but was a linesman in the final. Thankfully there were no major complaints about the officiating in the game but if we have a game that is controversial it could be perceived as a conflict of interest or a bad look if I am handing out medals in my reffing gear. I cannot guarantee that I will not be officiating in some of the final games of tournaments the rest of the season as sometimes there are no other officials available. All of our other tournaments are full with waiting lists, except U9, but that one will fill up later. A couple tournaments could even have more teams but we are literally out of accommodations for teams to stay at.
